Psychology tour to London - Tuesday 24 September to Wednesday 25 September 2024

The Psychology department is pleased to offer our annual school tour to London, supporting our A-level Psychology curriculum and enhancing learning experiences outside the school environment. This successful tour, running for almost 10 years, aims to ensure that all students receive the best learning experience beyond the classroom.

The key details about the planned trip are:

- 2 days and 1 night. Departs on Tuesday 24 September and returns on Wednesday 25 September 2024.
- The provisional cost is £225.00 per pupil (final cost will be communicated when known).
- The price includes travel to and from London by coach, departing from and returning to West Kirby Grammar School. The coach will remain with us whilst we are in London to take us to and from all venues.
- Bed and breakfast accommodation at Pax Lodge Hostel, Guiding Centre, London.
- The group size will be approximately 40 students plus 4 staff members.

The suggested itinerary for the trip includes:

- Facilitated tour & discussion at the Freud Museum.
- Jack the Ripper walking tour.
- Evening buffet meal with soft drink at Pizza Hut.
- Evening theatre visit to see 'Witness for the Prosecution' (Agatha Christie) at County Hall, London.
- Entrance to London Eye.
- Entrance to London Dungeon.
- Visit to the National History Museum.

To secure a place for your child/ward on this trip, a non-refundable deposit of £50.00 is required by Friday 5 July 2024. Please pay online and give consent, if appropriate, by using the online payment system (if this is likely to cause any financial difficulties, please contact Mr S Clarke, Headteacher, in confidence by email to office@wkgs.net). Your online payment serves as both consent and confirmation of updated emergency contact details. Contact details can be checked/updated via your Arbor app. Please ensure you provide any appropriate additional information directly to me.
