Dear Parents and Carers

As you will be aware, all Year 12 students have been asked to come into school for one morning during the final two weeks of term. Details of which day and time they should attend should have been received by School Comms email last Friday.

I wanted to take this opportunity give a reminder about the arrangements, as well as providing more details about the structure of the morning and required equipment.

Students should line up at the black gate by the Sixth Form Entrance and wait to be allowed in. Students should maintain a two metre separation from others whilst waiting outside and at all times during the morning session.

Students must ensure that they bring with them pen and paper and if possible a laptop or tablet. Please note that for hygiene reasons we will not be able to provide any of these items on the day; nor will students be able to borrow them from others in the class.

During the morning, students will receive advice and have discussions on study skills, applying to UCAS, for apprenticeships and jobs, completing their EPQ and Wellbeing.

I should also like to inform you about an additional Virtual Summer Programme session which is taking place from 2-4pm on Monday 6 July. Several students who left West Kirby Grammar School in 2015 to commence courses in STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) are going to be talking about their experiences and answering questions from our students. Although this will be primarily of interest to those wishing to undertake a similar course, they will offer general advice on the UCAS process and what to do if things don't always go to plan!
