**GCSE and A Level Drama Trip to London
Thursday 4 June to Friday 5 June 2026**

Your child/ward is being offered the opportunity to take part in an optional residential theatre visit to London on Thursday 4 to Friday 5 June 2026.

The visit will include return coach travel, one night's accommodation with breakfast in a central London hotel, an evening meal on Thursday, two theatre performances, a visit to The London Dungeons immersive show, and a backstage tour of the National Theatre.

This trip provides an excellent opportunity for students to enhance their understanding of theatre and to experience live performances relevant to the written component of the GCSE examination.

The anticipated cost of the visit will be approximately between £240 to £260, which may vary slightly depending on final numbers. To secure a place, please pay a non-refundable deposit of £50 online via scopay by Friday 12 December 2025. The remaining balance can be paid in two instalments of approximately £100 each, due on:

- Friday 27 February 2026
- Thursday 30 April 2026
