English Schools' FA Girls' Development Cup Final – Monday 8 July

As you may be aware, our U15s Football team have successfully made the finals of the ESFA Schools' FA Girls' Development Cup. 162 schools entered this competition, so it is a fantastic achievement that the team have made it to the final 2 schools.

As your child/ward has represented the school football team this year we are giving them the opportunity to watch this final and to cheer for our U15s team. The final is being held on Monday 8 July at the Sixways Stadium, Worcester. We will be playing against St Martin's School Brentwood (Chelmsford & Mid Essex SFA) with KO at 1.00pm. We will leave school at 9.00am and travel to and from the venue in a hired R&J coach with three members of the PE department. The match will be 40 minutes each way and is due to finish at 2.30pm. The medal/trophy presentation will be at 2.40pm and we anticipate leaving the stadium at 2.45pm to be back at school for around 5.30pm

The cost of the trip is £10, which includes the ticket and transportation to and from the event. Your child/ward can wear their own clothes but these need to be appropriate for the trip. If students have a blue school PE hooded sweatshirt, can they please bring these as well.
