Dear Students,

Following Ofqual's latest guidance on results, we are now in a position to explain our process for Results Day and how the day will work.

Results day for Year 11 will take place on Thursday 20th August, 2020.

Prior to Results Day, all current students are asked to complete the Google Form below to indicate whether they will collect their results in person or would rather receive them electronically. Those wishing to collect their results in person will be invited to school at staggered times, alphabetically, with the required social distancing measures in place. Please note that you will be required to collect these results individually and not with friends or additional family members to minimize any potential health risks. Please complete the form below **by July 17th** to indicate your chosen method of collection:

On the day, once you have collected or received your results, we will need you to confirm your place in the WKGS Sixth Form. To do this, you will need to complete the Google Form below once you have your results. If you have achieved the grades needed to access all of your chosen courses, you will just need to complete the form to confirm that you are joining us. If you would like to change a course or have not obtained the grades to study one or more of your preferred courses, on the Google Form you will need to request an online meeting with a member of the Senior Leadership Team, which will be scheduled for you that day via Microsoft Teams or Zoom. You will receive an email shortly after submitting the form to confirm the time of your online meeting. In this meeting you will be able to discuss your results and the courses available to you. Please note you will need to be logged in to Google with your school username and password to access the form.
