## A Level History trip, University of Liverpool - Monday 8 July 2024

Your child/ward is invited to the University of Liverpool on Monday 8 July in preparation for their A-level History coursework. Students will leave school at 12pm and travel by train from West Kirby Station with Mrs Gaskin. They will then walk to the university. During the visit, Dr Gillian O'Brien will present a short lecture on the History of Ireland in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Following the lecture, students will receive a guided tour of the university library.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch (if your child/ward is entitled to free school meals a 'grab bag' can be ordered the day before the trip from the canteen for collection from 8am on the day of the trip. 'Grab-bags' may also be ordered to purchase).

The tour will end at 4pm when students may leave from the library to make their own way home. Members of our staff will walk back to Lime Street Station and students may accompany them if they wish to catch a train.

There is no cost for this trip, but students are expected to purchase their own tickets to and from Liverpool Lime Street Station. They should also bring pens and notepads with which to work during the day.
