Gold Duke of Edinburgh

We are excited to have 27 students in Year 12 who are starting their Gold Award this year with us! The students attended a training day and kit check last Saturday in preparation for their trial expedition in Snowdonia next weekend. A reminder that the bus will depart from outside school at 6.30pm on Friday 4th October and the students will be dropped off back at school again at approximately 5.00pm on Sunday 6th October.

Some of these Year 12 students will also complete their Young Leader Award this year alongside the Gold Award - they will support all our younger DofE students and train to go out on the bronze expedition as leader helpers next year.

Silver Duke of Edinburgh (open to Year 11 students)

A reminder that the deposit to secure a place on the Silver Award is due by this Friday 27th September. Please note that this initial deposit will cover the student's registration with DofE UK and their Welcome Pack and is non-refundable.

Any students who have signed up for Silver but not completed a minimum of 3 sections of their bronze award by October half term will not be able to progress to Silver.

Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award (current Year 10 students)

We have 115 students in Year 10 now working hard to complete their activities prior to the expedition phase of the award next Spring.

Please be aware that students in Year 9 will be offered the opportunity to sign up for the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme in Spring 2025.

Duke of Edinburgh Support sessions are available every Thursday lunchtime in B10 to assist students with the administration of their eDofE accounts.


