**Theatre visit to the Playhouse Theatre, Liverpool
Thursday 24 October 2024**

I am delighted to be able to offer your child/ward an opportunity to take part in a Drama department visit to the Playhouse Theatre, Liverpool to see *After the Act, A Section 28 Musical*.

The play was created using verbatim and documentary theatre techniques and therefore, although optional, is highly recommended for Year 13 students as we are exploring this particular genre within our devising unit. The trip is also likely to inspire Year 12 students and will be beneficial should they choose to devise in the style of verbatim next year.

The trip will take place in the evening of Thursday 24 October. We will meet at West Kirby Grammar School at 5:30pm and walk to West Kirby Railway Station, where we will travel by train to Liverpool Central and then walk to the venue in Williamson Square. After the performance, we will return to school with an expected arrival back at West Kirby Grammar School at approximately 10:00pm. Students are required to adhere with these arrangements **unless** written communication is received by staff in advance of the trip.

The cost of the visit is £18 which includes school insurance, admin and entrance fees. Students will also require money to purchase their train ticket, unless they have a rail pass (£4.60 return).

Your online payment serves as both consent and confirmation of updated emergency contact details.
