Edukid

Our school has formed a unique partnership with Edukid and is committed to helping 7 children in Peru, one child per year group. The children live in the Amazon rainforest. Most live on just one meal a day and life is very much a daily struggle.

Edukid has arranged trips to Peru in July and October 2025 to enable students to build relationships with the local community and the children they are helping. These trips will enable students to experience the issues the children face and seek ways to help. The trips are designed to help students think about their values and role in the world. Many students who have travelled with Edukid on similar trips, have talked about how these trips have impacted on their career choice and helped them to develop personally.
