Monday – interform challenge (those not going to Snowdonia)

Staff in charge: Miss Ellis

- Come to school in uniform.
- Bring pens, pencils, scissors, glue.
- Canteen will be open or bring own lunch.

- Register all together in Main Hall, then go to Dining Room.
- You will be given instructions on the day.

Monday –Snowdonia
