#### **Mobile Phone Usage**

We are taking this opportunity to re-establish our expectations around mobile phone usage in school. To help students regulate their use of phones and social media, our policy is that phones should be switched off and away from 8:50am. Staff will not be asking students to use phones during the school day for any reason, so there should be no need for phones to be out at any time.

If a student needs to urgently contact home, they should go to Reception or Thrive, where staff can either make the call on their behalf or supervise them while they use their phone to do so. Similarly, if parents/carers need to urgently contact their child/ward, they should call Reception, who will ensure the message is passed on.

Attached to this newsletter are the details of our mobile phone confiscation protocol. We ask for your support in ensuring students adhere to these

expectations, as this helps us to create an environment where students can focus fully on their learning and wellbeing.

#### **Celebrations**

It has been another fantastic week of achievements at WKGS, and there is so much to be proud of within our community. This week, we hosted our Headteacher's Hot Chocolate and Pastries breaktime for students in Years 7–11 who achieved the highest number of Celebration and Community Points in the last half-term. These events are always a joy, offering a chance to recognise and celebrate students' hard work and positive contributions.

Our U16 badminton team has made history by reaching the 5th round of the National Badminton Competition, the first time this has ever been achieved by the school. #### **PTA AGM**

#### Y9 - GCSE Options

The second half of the spring term is an exciting time for our Y9 students, as they will be making their GCSE option choices. The deadline for this is 28th March 2025. In the lead up to this there will be lots of opportunities for students, parents and carers to ask questions and gather information about different GCSE subjects, discuss ideas and find out about the logistics of the process. In the first week back after February half term Mrs Fairclough will be delivering an Options Assembly to Y9 students to talk them through the process. Following this is the Y9 Progress

Evening on 26th February, this is an opportunity for parents/carers to discuss progress in each subject with teachers. The GCSE Options Evening is on 11th March, 5.30 - 7.30pm, where there will be a talk in the Main Hall and the opportunity to visit subject areas to ask questions and find out about each subject from Heads of Department. All Y9 students will have individual advice and guidance discussions with members of the senior leadership team, these will take place between 3rd and 21st March. Students are encouraged to talk about their option choices at home, with subject teachers and form tutors in order to make informed decisions. More information about each event will be emailed home closer to the time.

#### Y13 Mock Exams

Good luck to our Y13 students who are studying for their mock exams, taking place Monday 20 - Friday 24 January. Students only need to attend school for their examinations, however there is plenty of quiet space for them to study in school if required.


