**Religion and Culture Society Theatre Trip - 'Mean Girls the Musical', Liverpool Empire

The Religion and Culture Society has organised a theatre trip for current Year 10 and Year 12 Religious Studies students to see Mean Girls the Musical at the Liverpool Empire Theatre on Tuesday 20 October 2026.

This vibrant and energetic production explores themes of identity, belonging and the impact of peer pressure within social groups. Through humour and storytelling, it highlights issues of inclusion, exclusion and moral decision-making, linking Family and Relationships module and encouraging reflection on ethical behaviour, kindness and respect in everyday life.

The performance begins at 7:30pm. We will travel by coach, departing school at 6:15pm and returning at approximately 10:20pm. Students may remain in school after the end of the school day in the Dining Room but will need to bring a packed lunch for their evening meal. Parents/carers will need to arrange collection from school on our return.

The cost of the trip is £25, which includes the theatre ticket and return coach travel. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
