



## Further Details for Students

Time	Pupil Impact
<b>School Arrival</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students must stay in their year group bubble at all times and not mix outside of this during the school day. Students must maintain 2m social distancing from students in different year groups on arrival and throughout the school day.</li><li>• On arrival, students should safely remove reusable face coverings or dispose of dispensable face coverings if worn to travel to school. Guidance on doing this will be shared with students and displayed at school entrances.</li><li>• Students should sanitise hands before entering the building using the available sanitiser stations.</li><li>• Owing to the close proximity of many of our locker blocks, we are asking students in Y8 – 13 to not use a locker temporarily on our return to school. We appreciate that this may bring its own challenges but this will drastically reduce traffic around the school.</li><li>• Students may have to arrive at school outside of their allocated times owing to scheduled bus services but they should try to adhere to these suggested times wherever possible.</li><li>• Students are expected to wear full school uniform and adhere to the usual dress code as per government guidance.</li><li>• If students have a timetabled Core P.E. lesson, they should come to school in their P.E. kit on that day as changing spaces will be unavailable due to social distancing measures.</li><li>• Communal photocopiers and printers will be unavailable to students in the first instance and staff have been encouraged to set work that needs to be submitted via Google Classroom. Key pieces of coursework that must be printed should be sent to the Reprographics department via your subject teacher.</li></ul>
<b>Lessons</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Y7 &amp; 8 will be taught in Form Rooms for all subjects except P.E, Technology, Computing, Drama, Art and Music (Y8 only) to reduce movement around the school.</li><li>• Y9 – 13 will have lessons as per their individual timetables in order to access subject specific resources.</li><li>• Students must have their own general equipment as sharing of equipment is prohibited. Any specialist subjects requiring shared equipment will have disinfectant products which students will be asked to use at the end of each lesson to ensure the equipment is ready for use by an alternative year group.</li><li>• The School will have a full one-way system in place that must be followed at all times to minimise any mixing of year groups.</li></ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Easedale periods will only be delivered to Y12 students while social distancing measures are in place to prevent mixing of year group bubbles.</li><li>• Y12 should use G5 and Easedale during free periods and Y13 should use the Sixth Form Common Room and Upper Library.</li></ul>
<b>Break</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Dining Hall will be closed at breaktime and students are encouraged to bring any refreshments they may need with them.</li><li>• Students should return to form rooms in bad weather or are encouraged to go outside in good weather.</li><li>• Outdoor spaces will be allocated to year groups as follows to prevent any crossing of year group bubbles:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Y12 &amp; 13 – Tennis Court outside Easedale - Social Distancing rules to be adhered to between year groups</li><li>○ Y11 – Half of field behind Dining Hall</li><li>○ Y10 – Either quad (Dining Hall or Main Hall)</li><li>○ Y9 – Half of field behind Dining Hall</li><li>○ Y8 – Back Tennis Court (closest to Meols Drive)</li><li>○ Y7 – Front Tennis Court (closest to PE)</li></ul></li><li>• Students should use the following toilets at break or lunch to prevent over-crowding at key points:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Y7 – Junior Corridor</li><li>○ Y8 – Small Hall Corridor (closest to Small Hall)</li><li>○ Y9 – Small Hall Corridor (closest to Reception)</li><li>○ Y10 – Upstairs G Block (by Drama)</li><li>○ Y11 – Downstairs G Block (by Art)</li><li>○ Y12 – Easedale</li><li>○ Y13 – S Block</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>Lunch</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will follow staggered timings for use of the Dining Hall.</li><li>• Students are encouraged to bring packed lunch and can go straight to their outdoor space to eat in good weather. Students will return to form rooms to eat in poor weather. Sixth Form students can leave the site at lunch time and should sign in and out using their lanyard, as normal.</li></ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Dining Hall will be separated in half for different year groups. Colour coded chairs (half green and the other blue with a 2m gap in between) will indicate which half each year group should use and chairs and tables will be cleaned between year groups.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Students in Y7 should use green chairs and place their chair on the table when they are finished. This should be cleaned before Y9 use them.</li><li>○ Y8 will use blue and place their chair on the table for cleaning before Y10 arrive.</li><li>○ Y11 will then use green chairs as Y9 finish and Y12 will use blue. Year 13 will be the last to use the Dining Hall using the green half.</li><li>○ Chairs must be placed on the table by all students at the end of use to indicate the need for cleaning.</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>End of the School Day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students are dismissed at staggered intervals. Those requiring chartered bus services should go to the A rooms (Maths corridor) and wait to be called.</li><li>• Those using public buses should go straight to their bus after being dismissed. Further details of the full public bus service is still being confirmed with Wirral Local Authority.</li><li>• Students are encouraged to walk or cycle where possible and avoid using public transport.</li><li>• Students using Public Transport must adhere to the PHE guidance on doing so.</li></ul>
