## Year 12 Edge Hill University trip - Wednesday 22 May 2024

As part of our summer programme, we will be taking Year 12 students to Edge Hill University on Wednesday 22 May 2024. The aim of the trip is for all Year 12 students to be introduced to Higher Education in a campus university setting. This will help students to make informed decisions about their options post sixth form.

Students will arrive at school and meet in the dining hall to be registered at 08:50. Coaches will depart from school at 09:00 and arrive at Edge Hill at approximately 10:00 where students will experience a campus tour, introduction to Higher education lecture and a lecture on UCAS statement writing and/or budgeting. We will depart from Edge Hill at 14:30 and arrive back at school for 15:30 in time to travel home as normal. Lunch will be provided on the day.

The cost of the trip is £8. If you would like your child/ward to participate in this trip, please pay online as soon as possible and no later than **Wednesday 8 May**, by using the online payment system. Your online payment serves as both consent and confirmation of updated emergency contact details. Please note that continued poor behaviour and/or attendance will result in students not being allowed to participate in the trip. Any students not taking part in the trip will be required to attend school for supervised study.
