Our planning application for the development of a new Sports Hall and Sixth Form Centre has now been accepted and can be viewed here:

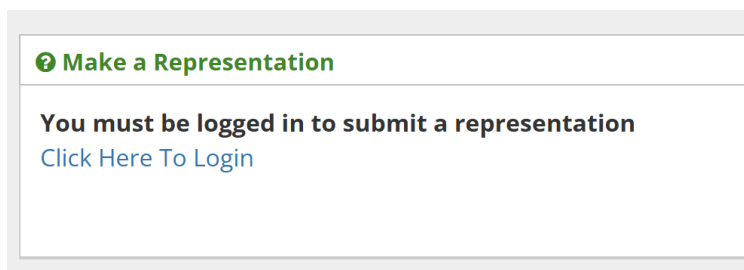
