**GCSE DT & A level Fashion & Textiles – London Design Study Tour  
Friday 8 November 2024**

We are pleased to offer our students the exciting opportunity of a study tour to visit the **NAOMI: In Fashion exhibition** at the Victoria & Albert Museum and **BARBIE: The Design exhibition** at the highly innovative Design Museum. This will directly support elements of theory and NEA coursework.

We will be travelling by train and using the tube from Euston. The day will consist of a full day across both venues, walking with a stop for lunch between sites, a visit to Liberty of London and an early evening meal before departure. Students must bring sketching equipment, sketchbook and a camera. Tasks to complete will be given.

The cost of this trip will be approximately £90 to include travel to London, tube travel to the venues, entrance fees and insurance. A deposit of £40 is required by Tuesday 3 September to secure a place. Please pay using the online payment system. Your payment serves as both consent and confirmation of updated emergency contact details. Contact details can be checked/updated via your Arbor app. Please ensure you provide any appropriate additional information directly to me (staff organising trip). We will update you with the final cost once we have gauged interest.

Please ensure that your child/ward has a packed lunch and money for refreshments throughout the day and for an evening meal. Exceptional behaviour, following directions and focus on tasks will be expected.
