What Next? Wirral Careers and Skills Show
Tuesday 12 November 2024

We are offering an amazing opportunity for all year 10 students to attend **What Next? Wirral Careers and Skills Show**. This will take place on Tuesday 12 November 2024 at the Hive (Wirral Youth Zone, Bright Street, Birkenhead).

There will be a wide range of exhibitors from universities, colleges, training providers and employers, covering all post-16 and post-18 options. A total of 60 exhibitors are expected. Students will have the opportunity to meet with these providers, ask questions, and collect promotional materials. They can take these materials away to research entry requirements and course structures, helping them to carefully consider their next steps.

All students will leave school at 9.30am and travel to the Hive by coach, spending an hour at the Skills Show, before returning to school at 11.30am to return to lessons.

Students are required to wear their full school uniform and will be accompanied by teaching and support staff.

The cost of the trip is £5, which includes the exhibit cost and transportation to and from the event.
