Year 10 Art Residential Visit – Conway Centre, Anglesey
Year 10 Fine Art/Graphics/Textile Design students
Friday 24 January to Sunday 26 January 2025

We are delighted to be offering our new GCSE Art students an exciting opportunity to take part in this residential course on the stunning Menai straits. Over the course of the weekend, the students will work with professional artists to explore, experiment and develop new and existing skills in a workshop format with the theme of “Mapping the Landscape”. The students will come home with a body of work and a final piece that can be included in their unit 1 personal investigation portfolio and can count towards their marks.

The total cost of the trip is £245 and covers all materials needed, food, accommodation, insurance and return coaches. Please note that this trip has limited spaces and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The non-refundable deposit will be £70 to be paid by 14 July. The remaining balance of £175 will be due by 30th September. This can either be made as one payment or as instalments.
