Year 9 RS Department Activities Week Cinema Trip

A visit has been arranged on Wednesday 3 July 2024 for our Year 9 students to see a private showing of the film 'One Life'. This film is about the life of Nicholas Winton who saved 600 Jewish children from being deported to concentration camps in Nazi Germany, arranging for them to come to England. His actions did not come to light until the 1980's. His story is one of courage and humility and an example of the power one individual has to make positive change in the world.

This event will take place at the Light cinema in New Brighton. We will leave school at 10:30am and travel by coach to the cinema and should return to school at approximately 1:30pm.

This trip is open to Year 9 students who are not already involved in another activity on this date. The cost of the trip is £10.00 which covers admission and travel costs. Students will need to bring a packed lunch on that day and are required to wear school uniform (if your child/ward is entitled to free school meals a 'grab-bag' can be ordered the day before the trip from the canteen for collection from 8am on the day of the trip. 'Grab-bags' may also be ordered to purchase).
