Dear Parents/Carers,

**A-level History & Politics' Trip to Westminster
Monday 23 to Tuesday 24 November 2026**

I am delighted to be able to offer your child/ward the opportunity to take part in the A-level History and Politics' Trip to Westminster. The trip, arranged in partnership with YHA and Polecon UK will take place in late November to coincide with an annual A-Level Politics conference that takes place in the Central Methodist Hall, Westminster. Departing from school on Monday 23 November at approximately 3.30am, we will travel by coach to Westminster to arrive at approximately 9am.

We will be staying for one night at YHA St Pauls with an evening meal and breakfast included in the cost. The second day will comprise of visits to Parliament, the Supreme Court and Parliament Square Garden.

We will depart for West Kirby at approximately 4pm and return to school late evening.

The cost of the trip is £175. This includes transport, insurance, accommodation cost (including dinner and breakfast) and cost of ticket to the Polecon UK Student Conference. A packed lunch will be required for the Monday. Your child/ward will require money for lunch and dinner on the second day and for any souvenirs they may wish to purchase.

A deposit of £90 is required by YHA and we kindly ask that is paid online via scopay by **Friday 18 September**. The final payment of £85 is due by **Friday 30 October**. Your online payment serves as both consent and confirmation of updated emergency contact details. Contact details can be checked/updated via your Arbor app. Please ensure you provide any appropriate addition information directly to me (staff organising trip). Please note that numbers for this trip are limited to 45 students.

Please be aware that withdrawing from the trip after a place is confirmed will mean that deposits cannot be returned, and further payments may need to be made. We do expect high demand for places so please adhere to the deadlines given. If the trip is oversubscribed names will be drawn at random in order to fill any vacant places.
