**Religion and Culture Society Trip for Years 10 & 11 – ‘Pig Heart Boy’ at the Liverpool Playhouse
Wednesday 19 March 2025**

The Religion and Culture Society has organised a trip, open to year 10 and 11 Religious Studies GCSE students, to a performance of ‘Pig Heart Boy’ at the Liverpool Playhouse Theatre on Wednesday 19 March 2025. The play is based upon the award winning novel by Mallorie Blackman OBE and explores the ethical issues around organ transplantation.

The performance starts at 5.30pm so the coach will leave school at 4.30pm and return at approximately 9.00pm. Your child/ward can stay in school after the end of the school day, in the Dining Room, but will need to provide their own packed lunch for their evening meal. You will need to arrange to collect your child/ward from school upon our return.

The cost of the trip is £19, which includes the theatre ticket and transportation to and from the event. There are a limited number of tickets available and therefore, will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
