GCSE Religious Studies Trip to Poland
Monday 28 September 2026 to Thursday 1 October 2026

We are pleased to share details of our proposed school trip to Poland in September 2026, offering students a valuable opportunity to deepen their understanding of history, culture, and global citizenship.

The trip is scheduled to depart on Monday 28 September 2026, returning on Thursday 1 October 2026. The estimated cost is between £890 and £950 per student, which will be confirmed once final numbers and arrangements, including flights, are in place.

To secure a place, we require a £200 deposit by Tuesday 9 December 2025. There are 40 places available, which will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

The trip cost will include:

- Return UK airport transfers
- Accommodation
- Overseas coach transfers as per the sample itinerary
- A visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau
- Entry to the Wieliczka Salt Mines
- Traditional Jewish dinner
- Entry to the Galicia Jewish Museum
- Entry to Schindler's Factory
- A half-day guided walking tour of Kazimierz (Jewish Quarter)
- Meals as outlined in the final itinerary

This promises to be an enriching and memorable experience for our students, combining historical learning with cultural exploration.
