Year 9 Activities Week 2026 – Trip Opportunities

We are pleased to inform you that Year 9 Activities Week will take place from Monday 29 June to Friday 3 July.

During this week, students will have the opportunity to take part in a range of trips and activities. We are writing to share the opportunities currently confirmed, with further details to follow in individual trip letters.

Confirmed residential trips

The following trips are already organised, and students will have signed up separately. Please note that students attending one of these trips will not be able to take part in other Activities Week trips:

- Germany Trip
- Sweden Handball Trip

London Theatre Trip

Students will have the opportunity to travel to London to see *Hadestown* at the Lyric Theatre, alongside a visit to the British Museum, where they will explore artefacts, including the Rosetta Stone.

- Date: Thursday 2 July
- Cost: £70

Local Cinema Trip

A more local option will be available for students:

- Date: Thursday 2 July or Friday 3 July
- Cost: approximately £10
- Further details to follow

Two-Day Trip: Alton Towers & Bletchley Park

Students may also apply for a two-day trip including:

- Date: Monday 29 and Tuesday 30 June
- A day at Alton Towers
- A visit to Bletchley Park, famous for its role in wartime codebreaking
- Cost: £168
- Further details to follow

As individual trip letters are released, students will be able to sign up for any trips they are interested in attending.

Please note that while students may sign up for more than one trip, some trips will have limited places available. If more students apply than there are places, we will work carefully to ensure that as many students as possible have the opportunity to take part in at least one trip during the week.

We hope this range of activities offers something for everyone and provides a memorable and rewarding end to the school year for our Year 9 students.
