**Year 12 Work Experience
Monday 29 June to Friday 3 July 2026**

As you are aware, work experience in the Sixth Form is now a **compulsory one-week placement** and will be undertaken by all Lower Sixth students from **Monday 29 June to Friday 3 July 2026**.

Work experience provides a valuable opportunity for students and supports applications for university, apprenticeships, internships, and future careers. The week enables students to broaden their experience, develop communication and employability skills, and gain insight into their chosen career pathways.

Courses where work experience is particularly beneficial include Architecture, Medicine, Social Work, Dentistry, Nursing/Midwifery, Speech Therapy, Engineering, Occupational Therapy, Teaching, Theatre, Law, Physiotherapy, Veterinary Science, Finance, and Accounting.

Students are expected to source their own placements; however, a limited number of contacts may be available should difficulties arise.

Once a placement has been secured, students must complete the online Microsoft Form by **Friday 27 March** using the link below:

To complete the form, students **must request the employer's Public Liability Insurance details and policy number**.
