**Year 7 Residential Visit to PGL – Boreatton Park, Shropshire
Wednesday 2 July – Friday 4 July 2025**

All Year 7's are encouraged to take part in this residential trip which will develop their personal and social skills. This trip will take place from Wednesday 2 July to Friday 4 July 2025.

Boreatton Park is a purpose-built outdoor activity centre near Shrewsbury. During the visit students will be given the opportunity to take part in a range of activities such as kayaking, orienteering, archery and climbing. All the staff at the centre are suitably qualified to instruct the various activities and all specialist equipment required is provided by the centre. The students will also be accompanied by West Kirby staff on all activities.

The total cost of the trip, including all transport, food, accommodation, activities, insurance costs and coaches, is £320. A non-refundable deposit of £100 is due by Wednesday 9 October 2024. The remaining balance of £220 will be paid in two instalments: £100 by Friday 28 February 2025 and £120 by Tuesday 22 April 2025.
