Year 8 Art and Design Research Trip to the World Museum, Liverpool Tuesday 2 July 2024

The Art and Design Department are pleased to offer an exciting opportunity for 70 Year 8 students to visit the World Museum in Liverpool during activities week on Tuesday 2 July. The purpose of the trip is to explore the museum collections and gather research in preparation for the Art and Design curricular projects studied during Year 9. It will give an interesting insight into natural forms and world cultures. Students will be able to record observations via photographs and sketches, as well as recording written ideas and thoughts. The trip will focus on the collections of insects and butterflies.

The cost of this trip is £6.50 and includes return transport to Liverpool via coach, entrance fees and insurance.

Students will spend time in the Art and Design Department being briefed on the research and recording tasks before departing at 11:00am. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and refreshments for the day, as no break is scheduled during museum time. There will be time allocated before we leave at 11:00am for students to take refreshments as well as on the outbound and return coach journeys. If your child/ward is entitled to free school meals a 'grab bag' can be ordered the day before the trip from the canteen for collection from 8am on the day of the trip. 'Grab-bags' may also be ordered to purchase.

The trip will return at 3:30pm.

If you would like your child/ward to participate in this exciting opportunity, please complete and return the attached permission slip to the art department and make payment online via Scopay before Friday 14 June. Please note we are limited to 70 students due to museum regulations, therefore places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
