Following on from our success in the semi-finals of the English Schools' FA Girls' Development Cup, the finals of the competition will be held on Monday 8 July at the Sixways Stadium, Worcester. We will be playing against St Martin's School Brentwood (Chelmsford & Mid Essex SFA).

We have been asked to arrive at the Sixways Stadium for 12:00pm so will be leaving school at 8:00am. We will travel to and from the venue on the school minibus. The warmup starts at 12:20pm and KO is at 1:00pm. The match will be 40 minutes each way, so it is due to finish at 2:30pm. The medal/trophy presentation will be at 2.40pm. I have included the match day itinerary and a parent's letter from the FA with more details for you, should you wish to attend. We will leave the stadium at 3:30pm and we expect to be back at school around 7:30pm.
