Dear Parents/Carers

Year 7 Residential Visit to PGL – Boreatton Park, Shropshire
Wednesday 1 July to Friday 3 July 2026

I am delighted to inform you about our Year 7 summer residential trip. All Year 7 students are encouraged to take part in this exciting residential trip which is designed to develop their personal and social skills. This trip will take place from Wednesday 1 July to Friday 3 July 2026.

We will be visiting Boreatton Park, a purpose-built outdoor activity centre near Shrewsbury. During the visit, students will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of activities such as kayaking, orienteering, archery, and climbing. All activities are led by fully qualified instructors, with all specialist equipment provided by the centre. Students will also be accompanied by West Kirby Grammar School staff throughout the trip.

The total cost of the trip, which includes transport, food, accommodation, activities, insurance, and staffing, is £330. The payment schedule is as follows:

- £50 non-refundable deposit due by Monday 13 October 2025.
- £150 second payment due by Monday 2 March 2026.
- £130 final balance due by Thursday 30 April 2026.

Payments should be made via the school's online payment system. Please note that while the dates above are the final deadlines, you may pay in advance or in instalments, as long as the deadlines are met. If this cost presents any financial difficulty, please contact Mr S Clarke, Headteacher, in confidence, by emailing office@wkgs.net.

Your online payment will serve as both consent for your child to attend and confirmation that emergency contact details held on Arbor are up to date. Please ensure that you review and amend any information on your Arbor app as required and provide me directly with any additional relevant details.
