As part of our commitment to informing students about their post-school options, we are organising a trip to the upcoming Apprenticeship Fair in Liverpool on Wednesday 27 November. The trip is an excellent opportunity for Year 12 and 13 students who are interested in pursuing an apprenticeship, as they will have the opportunity to speak with representatives from various industries all in one place. The aim is to help students explore the different routes available to them after Year 13.
