Year 12 Social Afternoon at Star Pins, Liverpool – Tuesday 23 June 2026

We are pleased to invite Year 12 students to a social afternoon at Star Pins in Liverpool (School Lane).

The event will take place on Tuesday 23 June from 4:00pm and will finish at 6:00pm. Students will enjoy a range of activities, including two hours of bowling, ice-free curling lanes, shuffleboard, tech darts and a karaoke room. Food and drink are included (pizza, fries, chicken tenders and unlimited squash), and students may also purchase additional items if they wish.

The cost of the event is £18 per student. To allow us to confirm numbers, please make payment via [Scopay](#) by Tuesday 19 May.

Students will be given permission to leave school after Lesson 5 and will be expected to make their own way to Star Pins (approximately a four-minute walk from Liverpool Central Station), as well as arrange their own journey home afterwards. We suggest that students travel via the Merseyrail service from West Kirby to Liverpool Central, which takes just over 30 minutes and costs approximately £6.70 for a return ticket.

If any students would prefer to travel with staff, Mrs Begbie and Mrs Duffey will be taking the train from West Kirby station shortly after 3:00pm. Students are welcome to join them; if so, please ask them to inform Mrs Begbie so that meeting arrangements can be shared.

Payment via Scopay will be taken as consent for attendance and acknowledgement that students are responsible for arranging and funding their own transport to and from the venue.

We hope this will be a fun and enjoyable opportunity for students to socialise together.
