**Warner Bros. Studio Tour London – The Making of Harry Potter
Current Year 10 and Year 12 Fine Art/Graphics/Textile Design students
Monday 23 September 2024**

We are delighted to be offering students an exciting opportunity to visit Warner Bros. Studio Tour London – The Making of Harry Potter on Monday 23 September 2024, leaving school at approximately 7.30 am and returning to school at approximately 10.00 pm.

The trip costs £51.50 and covers all activities listed below, as well as transportation with Carvers coaches. Students will need to bring a pack lunch, snacks and water for the duration of the day along with some money for purchasing food at a service station, such as McDonald's, for their tea on our return home.

Included in the trip cost are entrance tickets to Warner Bros. Studio Tour London, a green screen broomstick experience and participation in a 45-minute lesson led by qualified teachers at the Warner Bros. studios in a purpose-built.

During these lessons students will have the option to explore either Set design and how the production designers tackle a script, examining the process from sketch to storyboard and model, resulting in the final set or Movie Graphic Design, learning the processes involved in creating movie graphics, from Weasleys' Wizard Wheezes products to copies of the Daily Prophet newspapers. These lessons will offer students an amazing experience outside of the classroom to explore and discover the extraordinary artistry, technology and techniques that went into creating the Harry Potter film series. These Art & Design lessons provide students with the opportunity to study the design processes and the level of detail required to design and make props, costumes and sets in a film. Exploring world famous costumes, carefully crafted props and intriguingly designed white card models, students will learn the secrets of the art department and film making. On top of this valuable experience, I hope that this visit will inspire students in extending their knowledge and understanding of the many different career opportunities available within the creative industries.
