Wirral Changemakers Conference (Start Yard, Birkenhead) - Friday 9 May 2025

Your child/ward has been representing our school in the Wirral Eco-Council creating a campaign to improve local transport for young people in Wirral. Students will present their ideas on fairer rail pricing for young people and live transport information at bus stops at the Wirral Changemakers Conference to a panel of decision makers. This fantastic opportunity for students has developed their leadership, communication, creative and organisation skills, while contributing to a campaign of enacting change in their local area.

The Wirral Changemakers Conference event will take place between 10am and 2.30pm at the Start Yard in Birkenhead on Friday 9 May. Students will pitch their ideas to key decision makers such as local councillors and politicians, representatives from the Liverpool City Region Combined Authority and public transport providers.

We will leave school at 9.10am and travel by train from West Kirby Station to Hamilton Square Station, followed by a 10-minute walk to the Start Yard. Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them. If your child/ward is entitled to free school meals a 'grab bag' can be ordered the day before the trip from the canteen for collection from 8am on the day of the trip. Grab bags can also be purchased.

We will return by train arriving back at West Kirby by 3.35pm. Train travel is free for students, covered by EcoClub funds.

In case there are any delays on the train, students will need to be responsible for arranging their own transport home. If your child/ward would like to make their own way home from Hamilton Square Station or a different stop on the West Kirby line, please indicate this on the permission slip below.
