GERMAN TELEVISION NEWS

There are various news sites in German, including one called *Tagesschau in einfacher Sprache*. This is a televised broadcast available online and is updated each evening at 6.00pm. Each programme includes 4-5 news stories.

Task: You should watch at least one broadcast each week throughout August. Each broadcast last approximately 10 minutes. This will give you access to 16-20 news items in total.

You should keep a record of each of the news items you have watched, including the date you accessed it. For each news item, make a list of any new words you have encountered, together with their English meaning.
